INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING THE 186630 MODIFICATION KIT TO PROVIDE BREAK DETECTION AND INDICATION ON MODEL 33 AND 35 SETS EQUIPPED WITH THE 186627 SET LOGIC OR 109C OR 109F TYPE DATA SET

1. GENERAL

1.01 The 186630 modification kit provides a signal line break detection and indication feature on Model 33 and 35 KSR and ASR Sets using the 186627 set logic assembly. The kit can also be used on teletypewriters, equipped with 109C or 109F type Data Set in the Data Line Concentrator System, if a 344318 cable assembly is used. The 344318 cable assembly is not part of the 186630 modification kit and must be ordered separately.

1.02 On detection of a break in the receive signal line, the 186630 kit will stop the tape reader on ASR sets, shunt the send signal line, light an

indicator on the faceplate, and permit manual reset by means of a pushbutton containing the break indicator lamp.

1.04 Additional information as to the necessary faceplates required, and the sets with which this kit is compatible, is given in Tables A through C.

1.05 For part numbers referred to, other than the parts in the kit, and for parts ordering information see Teletype Parts Bulletin 1184B (Model 33)

or 1187B (Model 35). Teletype Bulletin 280B, Vol 1 and Vol 2 contain the adjustments and lubrication information for Model 35 equipment. Teletype Bulletin 310B, Vol 1 and Vol 2 contain the adjustments and lubrication information for Model 33 equipment.

Note: When the sets in Tables A through C are used with a 109C or 109F type Data Set, the 336463 cable is required and must be ordered separately.

2. INSTALLATION

2.01 On ASR sets only, remove the yellow strap between terminals F and H on the break detector card connector "CN" of UCC29. The strap must be removed to stop the tape reader on receipt of a line break.

2.02 Assemble the modification kit per Figure 3 on the Model 33 set. On Model 35 sets, mount the 336462 bracket to the spacer plate per Figure

4. Use the lower pair of holes on the 336462 bracket to mount the 336465 bracet on Model 35 sets.

2.03 When the modification kit is used with the 109C or 109F Data Set, discard the 336471 cable. Unplug the 336463 cable assembly from the rear of the UCC29, positions 1 and 2. Plug one end of the 344318 cable assembly, ordered separately, into the call control unit, positions 1 and 2. Coil the 336463

cable from the data set above the data set on Model 33 or in back of the data set on Model 35, and plug it into the other end of the 344318 cable assembly.

2.04 When used with the 186627 set logic assembly, connect the 336471 cable with the <u>R-S lead to TB13</u>, R-BR to TB6, BL to TB12, and O-G to TB9.

2.05 Remove and discard the 119634 button plug from the hole in the faceplate labeled BRK RLS.

2.06 With the data set or set logic assembly positioned front to rear so the 635 type keyswitch does not bind the opening of the faceplate, position the 336462 bracket so that the break reset switch and indicator lamp projects through the faceplate approximately in the middle of its free travel on its shoulder screws. Adjust the vertical position of the 336465 lamp bracket so that the bottom edge of the lens is just below the faceplate.

3. THEORY OF OPERATION

3.01 The 303833 break detector card consists of two timing circuits and a relay. One timing circuit is used to delay the input signal by a nominal 1.5 milliseconds. This allows the second timing circuit which is the break timer to tolerate a 1.5 milliseconds marking pulse during the break signal which may result from noise on the line. The card mounts in an existing card connector above the power supply section of the UCC29 call control unit. The output of the card terminates at the primary interface connectors no. 1 (CAH) and no. 2 (CAJ) at the rear of the call control unit.

<u>Note</u>: The interface is brought out to the control logic in one of two ways, depending on which package is used.

3.02 The interface may be brought out in a one-to-one extension cable, 336464, which is part of the 186627 set logic assembly, with Molex connectors on both ends. When used in this application, the break lamp and reset switch are connected in the circuit by the customer at the time of installation by placing spade lugs of the 336471 cable under specified screw terminals on the 186627 logic assembly. Refer to Figure 2.

3.03 The interface may also be brought out in a cable, 336463, with spade lugs on one end for use with the 109C or 109F type Data Sets. When used in this application, the break lamp and reset switch are connected in the circuit by having their wire leads factory crimped to the proper points in the 344318 cable. One end of the cable is plugged into the UCC29 call control unit and the other end is then plugged into the 336463 cable assembly. The 336471 cable assembly is discarded when the modification kit is used with these data sets. Refer to Figure 1.
